Concepts, models, operational considerations and requisite social work skill sets for practice are articulated by professionals experienced in this rapidly evolving approach to concurrently providing physical health and mental health care.

Immigration: Health Care Social Work Policy and Practice Issues

This publication address the unique issues faced by health care professionals as they attempt to formulate policy and manage services to immigrant populations with a myriad of diverse health care needs ranging from preventative to immediate. With a rich historic background of intervening with immigrants, social work represents a particularly valuable organizational and community asset in identifying and responding to service population needs.

The increasing racial, ethnic, cultural and linguistic diversity of America, coupled with continuing disparities in illness and death among people of color presents a significant challenge to health care providers. Culture has a fundamental bearing on decisions of how health care services are offered and utilized. Sensitivity to the values, norms, traditions, belief systems and histories of differing client populations consequently is crucial if such services are to be appropriately targeted, accessed and utilized. The text will prove a useful, contemporary addition to any health care professional's library.

Ethics in Health Care: A Social Work Perspective

Supervision of Health Care Social Work: Principles and Practice

This text focuses on how to effectively lead in a tumultuous health care environment characterized by changes in patient populations, health care technologies, professional practices, community needs/expectations and rapid shifts in service delivery modalities. In this environment, health care professionals are increasingly challenged to develop and oversee staff capable of delivering contemporary benchmark professional practice. Supervision of staff and programs becomes more crucial than ever before. Competent supervision requires practice knowledge, keen perspective and the ability to support, guide, educate and direct practitioners of varying skill and experience.

Senior Services Delivery: Ethical Issues and Responses

With the numbers of seniors aged 65 and older expected to rise from a current level of 38 million to nearly 90 million by the year 2050, attention to this population becomes of paramount importance for the profession of social work. This edition of the Exemplars Series focuses on selected aspects of senior service delivery particularly as they pose ethical dilemmas to care providers. Highlighted are creative programs addressing psychosocial issues for individuals' coping with the aging process, their care givers, and the communities in which they live.

Health Care Social Work Leadership: in Crisis and Disaster Response

Often unexpected and without warning, these events have taxed individuals and communities as they make effort to both recover from the immediate circumstance and put into place mechanisms to minimize recurrence of such threat.
