Dear Friends,

I am with the Willamette Falls Chapter of the Coastal Conservation Association of Oregon. CCA is a non-profit 501c3 organization. My hope is that after reading about our organization below, you will help us by providing a donation to our banquet fundraiser event. Locally, our chapter is involved in a project to enhance recreational salmon fishing on the Molalla River. We built an acclimation pond which imprints 100,000 hatchery Spring Chinook salmon smolts each year prior to their release into the Molalla River. As of 2019 we will have introduced 700,000 salmon to this watershed. After just a few years, salmon are returning to the Molalla in numbers enhancing the local recreational fishery and economy.

CCA Oregon has been very busy protecting our Oregon fisheries, recreational anglers and opportunities to fish. The Columbia River Reform is removing gillnets from the main stem Lower Columbia River and is protecting endangered runs of salmon and steelhead. It has established a recreational fishing priority making this resource more available to the general public and stimulating Oregon's economy by over 1.1 billion dollars!

CCA Oregon is clearly the strongest fish advocacy nonprofit in Oregon. We publicly recognize our supporters and donors at all our events. Your support is important because the stronger our backing, the more CCA Oregon will be able to accomplish for recreational anglers and our precious natural resources.
